



Online Degree-Seeking International Student Admission

Document Requirements

- ___ Complete a SJC application using your complete name as it appears on your passport. Note: Admission to San Juan College does not guarantee admission into any entirely online program.

- ___ An official copy of TOEFL or IELTS score results must be sent directly to the Office of Admissions. The minimum acceptable score for the TOEFL is 550 on the paper test or 75 on the internet-based version or an Academic IELTS overall band score of 6.0. Students from the following countries do NOT have to submit English Proficiency score results:

American Samoa, Anguilla, Antigua & Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Canada (except Quebec), Cayman Islands, Dominica, Fiji, Gambia, Ghana, Gibraltar, Grenada, Guam, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Liberia, Montserrat, New Zealand, Saint Kitts & Nevis, Santa Lucia, Saint Vincent & the Grenadines, Sierra Leone, Trinidad/Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands, United Kingdom, Virgin Islands

- ___ All high school/college transcripts, translated in English, must be provided. These transcripts **must** be sent directly to the Registration & Records Office at transcripts@sanjuancollege.edu from any NACES member organization (visit <http://www.naces.org>). Transcripts directly from the international school or from the student will NOT be accepted. Students must have completed a secondary school and been awarded a diploma with a U.S. equivalent grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. If the student has completed 15 college-level credits with a minimum 2.0 GPA, the requirement of official high school transcripts is waived.

- ___ Complete online New Student Orientation before registering for class.

*Online international students pay non-resident tuition and general fees. Please refer to the Tuition & Payment webpage for current rates: <https://www.sanjuancollege.edu/admissions-aid/tuition-fees/>. If at any point online international students wish to change to “regular” admission status (attending face-to-face classes toward a degree), they will need to satisfy all the “regular degree-seeking international student” admissions requirements. Note: online programs are not eligible for student visa application.

**All academic records and supporting documents must be official and must be submitted to “San Juan College – Office of Admissions – 4601 College Blvd – Farmington, NM – 87402” or admissions@sanjuancollege.edu (transcripts from a member NACES organization should be sent to transcripts@sanjuancollege.edu). Admission to the college will not be offered until all criteria have been met and all documents have been received by the date requested.

***Transcripts and test scores submitted to San Juan College for admission become the property of the College and will not be sent elsewhere or returned to the student.
