

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION

Document Requirements

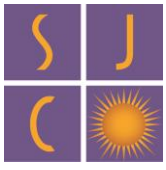
- ___ Complete a SJC application using your complete name as it appears on your passport.
- ___ Copy of passport
- ___ Provide proof of current health and accident insurance. International students who attend SJC and any dependents who may accompany them are required to have medical insurance. If your health insurance is international, you must have coverage while in the U.S. Note: SJC does not offer student health insurance plans and it is up to the student to demonstrate they have a health insurance policy.
- ___ Complete official SJC Financial Responsibilities form along with required supporting documentation (including financial statement) and send copy to Enrollment Services. Note: all international applicants are required to submit documentation verifying adequate funding to meet study and living expenses while in the U.S. The signed and verified financial statement must show an account balance of no less than \$25,000 USD.
- ___ An official copy of TOEFL or IELTS score results must be sent directly to the Enrollment Services office. The minimum acceptable score for the TOEFL is 550 on the paper test or 75 on the internet-based version or an Academic IELTS overall band score of 6.5. Students from the following countries do NOT have to submit English Proficiency score results:

American Samoa, Anguila, Antigua & Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Canada (except Quebec), Cayman Islands, Dominica, Guam, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Liberia, Montserrat, New Zealand, Saint Kitts & Nevis, Santa Lucia, Saint Vincent & the Grenadines, Trinidad/Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands, United Kingdom, Virgin Islands
- ___ All high school/college transcripts, translated in English, must be provided. These transcripts **must** be sent directly to the Enrollment Services office from WES at <http://www.wes.org/> or any NACES member <http://www.naces.org>. Transcripts directly from the international school or from the student will NOT be accepted. Must have completed a secondary school and been awarded a diploma. A U.S. equivalent grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- ___ Submit application and all supporting documents and credentials (stated above) by the application deadlines as indicated:

May 1: Fall Semester (August)

October 1: Spring Semester (January)

February 1: Summer Semester (May)
- ___ Once you have received a copy of your I-20 you must login to [www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/students/form to pay the \\$200 SEVIS fee](http://www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/students/form%20to%20pay%20the%20$200%20SEVIS%20fee). The receipt must be turned into the Enrollment Services Office.

PLEASE NOTE: I-20 Statement

The Immigration Form I-20 is valid up to the first day of class for the semester or summer session in which you are admitted. If you are not able to attend, you will need to work with your advisor to see about getting a new I-20 for another term.
